English Course Details

The structure of the course is divided into 4 main Levels:

Beginners Level: (Absolute Beginners)

Outcome: Salutations & Meet and Greet people. You will be able to lead Informal Communication in your daily routine. Be able to structure simple sentences, be able to lead simple conversations like at the cafe, at the restaurant, hotel reservations, directions, buying and selling etc. The grammatical elements like the parts of speech and few the other essentials would be covered up in this level. After the level 1 you will be able to speak, write, listen and read English fairly well.

Elementary English: (People who know English but fear to form Sentences Independently)

Outcome: You will be able to lead informal Communication in your daily routine. Be able to structure complex sentences; be able to lead complex conversations like at the office, in an interview, dialogue between 2 friends discussing about a specific topic etc. The grammatical elements like types of tenses, irregular verbs and the other essentials would be covered up in this level. After the Regular English level you will be able to Speak, Write, Listen & Read complex sentences in English.

Intermediate / Advanced English: (People who can form Sentences Independently)

Outcome: You will be able to lead formal Communication at your work place. Be able to structure critical complex sentences and conversations; be able to write complex texts in the letterform. The complex grammatical elements like Subjunctive, active passives etc. are included

in this Level. Be able to lead group discussions and debate type conversations. After the Advanced level you will be able to Speak, Write, Listen & Read long paragraphs in English.

Creative Writing and Voice Neutralisation (Fluent English Speakers)

Personalized Tuition; Outcome: You will enhance your presentational and Conversational Skills. Be able to use complex vocabulary; be able to construct complex texts in the letter and email form.

IELTS, TOEFL & PTE

IELTS, the International English Language Testing System, is designed to assess the language ability of candidates who need to study or work where English is used as the language of communication.

Who is it for? – Universities and employers in many countries, including Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, the UK and the USA, recognize IELTS. Professional bodies, Immigration Authorities and other government agencies also recognize it. More than 1.4 million people a year take the test.

What is the IELTS test like?

You can choose between the Academic or General Training versions of the test. All candidates do the same Listening and speaking sections. The test has four sections:

1. Listening – 4 sections, 40 questions, 30 minutes
2. Speaking – interview, 15 minutes
3. Reading – different for Academic or General Training – 3 sections, 40 questions, 60 minutes
4. Writing – different for Academic or General Training – 2 pieces of writing, 60 minutes
