

Why Sanskrit

Beginners Level (30 Hours)

Outcome:

- Grammatical components such as parts of speech, tenses, connectors, and other essentials would be included at this level.

Intermediate Level (30 Hours)

- At this level, the emphasis is on improving your oral abilities. It is only appropriate for students who have completed the basic course.
- This level can help you go deeper into the language while also boosting your confidence!
- You will be able to construct complicated phrases, make requests and suggestions, and narrate future occurrences at this level.

Advanced Level (40 Hours)

- Are you ready to advance to the master level of your language? At this level, we will strive to improve your knowledge and boost your confidence, giving you wings to improve your listening, writing, and reading abilities.
- This level will also allow you to apply your adaptability and effectiveness to social, academic, and professional objectives.
