THE INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE TESTING SYSTEM

IELTS, the International English Language Testing System, is designed to assess the language ability of candidates who need to study or work where English is used as the language of communication.

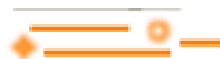
Who is it for?

Universities and employers in many countries, including Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, the UK and the USA, recognize IELTS. Professional bodies, Immigration Authorities and other government agencies also recognize it. More than 1.4 million people a year take the test.

What is the IELTS test like? You can choose between the Academic or General Training versions of the test. All candidates do the same Listening and speaking sections.

The test has four sections:

1. Listening – 4 sections, 40 questions, 30 minutes
2. Speaking – interview, 15 minutes
3. Reading – different for Academic or General Training – 3 sections, 40 questions, 60 minutes
4. Writing – different for Academic or General Training – 2 pieces of writing, 60 minutes
