BEGINNERS LEVEL

INTERNATIONAL EXAMINATION FOR ITALIAN LANGUAGE

The Italian language competence examination has six primary certificates. While all of the examinations are globally recognized, whether you choose a certificate or diploma is determined by your personal or professional objectives. The CILS test (Certificazione di Italiano come Lingua Straniera or Certification of Italian as a Foreign Language) is a proficiency exam and an official certification of the degree of linguistic competence in Italian as a foreign language acquired. It is aimed at people who are studying Italian or who plan to (or are currently) work or study in Italy or an Italian setting. Appearing for these exams will add a bonus to your resume and help you to grow.
