# BEGINNERS LEVEL

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**Hours: 30**



## Outcome

- This is a first step, where the learners are introduced to the culture.
  - Understands and uses common everyday idioms and very simple sentences geared at satisfying actual requirements.
  - Could identify himself/herself and others, as well as ask and answer questions regarding personal data such as where he/she lives, individuals he/she knows, and possessions.
  - Will converse in a straightforward manner if the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to assist.
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# ELEMENTARY LEVEL

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**Hours: 35**



## Outcome

- At this level, students are learning how to function successfully in social situations.
  - Be able to greet individuals, inquire about their well-being, and react to news using simple common courtesy words. This level will help you stand out from the crowd of newcomers.
  - Grammatical components such as parts of speech, tenses, connectors, and other essentials would be included at this level.
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# INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

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**Hours: 40**



## Outcome

- At this level, the emphasis is on improving your oral abilities. It is only appropriate for students who have completed the basic course.
  - This level can help you go deeper into the language while also boosting your confidence!
  - You will be able to construct complicated phrases, make requests and suggestions, and narrate future occurrences at this level.
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# ADVANCED LEVEL




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**Hours: 40**

- At this level, we will strive to improve your knowledge and boost your confidence, giving you wings to improve your listening, writing, and reading abilities.
  - This level will also allow you to apply your adaptability and effectiveness to social, academic, and professional objectives.
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# INTERNATIONAL EXAMINATION FOR THE KOREAN LANGUAGE

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TOPIK, or Examination of Proficiency in Korean, is a written test meant to assess non-native speakers' ability to express and comprehend Korean. The TOPIK examination assesses reading, writing, and listening comprehension in the Korean language. TOPIK test has two levels – TOPIK-I and TOPIK-II. TOPIK-I, i.e. the beginner level, has two sublevels – 1 & 2 while TOPIK-II, i.e. Intermediate-Advanced level, has 4 sublevels – 3, 4, 5 & 6. Test takers get a level between 1 and 6 based on their total score in the test. Test takers who meet the requirements will be issued a formal certificate with one of six possible grades: low beginner (level 1), high beginner (level 2), low intermediate (level 3), high intermediate (level 4), low advanced (level 5), and high advanced (level 6).

Please Note: The certificate issued by any Private Institution is not recognized globally.
