BEGINNERS LEVEL

Hours: 30

- •Could identify himself/herself and others, as well as ask and answer questions regarding personal data such as where he/she lives, individuals he/she knows, and possessions.
- •Will converse in a straightforward manner if the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to assist.





ELEMENTARY LEVEL
